Judge Einhorn is known for more than his judicial and humanitarian work. He is an author, a scholar and a professor of law, teaching Professional Liability and other topics at Pepperdine University School of Law. He has also enjoyed success in the entertainment industry as a Hollywood scriptwriter and consultant on movies and television shows. He
